Middle School Championships

3 minute matches

No Arm Bars

Chokes will be allowed only if both athletes are 13 years old or older. Athletes and coaches shall inform the officials when an under 13 year old athlete is about to compete.

High School Championships

Full IJF RULES (arm bars and strangles)

5 minute matches

Modified Double elimination (True Double elimination for 4 or less competitors)

Eligibility:

University Competitors:

*Must be enrolled in a college / university for the 2008 spring semester and must be a full time student according to the institutions regulations.

*Must have the official university seal embossed or attached to the entry form.

Middle School and High School Competitors

The Middle School Category will include 7th, 8th, and 9th grades only.

*EXCEPTION: 6th Grade students may compete in the Middle School Championships if they meet one of the following:

1. On the Juvenile B or IJF Junior roster
2. Placed 1st - 3rd at the USJA, USJF or Jr Olympic Nationals in the Juvenile A division OR placed 1st - 5th in the under 15 year old division at the Junior US Open.

The High School Category will include 10th, 11th, and 12th grades with the **exception that 9th graders may elect to compete in the High School Category INSTEAD OF the Middle School category.**

1. Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
2. Agree that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment facilities, competition pools or divisions and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
3. Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, and severe social and economic losses due to not only my own actions, inactions, or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
4. Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability, or death.
5. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the United States Judo, Inc.
