The 27th National Collegiate Judo Association Championships were held at the Ohio State University in Columbus, Ohio on April 4, 1987. 53 schools were represented on this day. All 173 competitors, grouped by school, marched into the Green Gym to the tune of the Ohio State University Buckeye Fight Song. The tournament was officially opened by Mr. F. Beekman, Chairman of the Intramural Department of Ohio State University. He gave the welcoming address. Mr. A. Lambert, the newly elected president of the National Collegiate Judo Association, gave the opening address.

The tournament used the European Pool System with 5 minute matches for the men and 4 minute matches for the women in both preliminary and final matches. Mr. W. Rosenberg, Morehead State University, co-ordinated this phase of the tournament. The results of the top three places in each weight division are listed on the first two pages of the accompanying handout.
